

Incubation Programme: Cohort 10

NABI successfully conducted the 10th Cohort of Startup Agri-Business Incubation Programme (SABIP) and Agripreneurship Orientation Programme (AOP) from 19th June 2024 to 27th July 2024. NIAM Agribusiness Incubator (NABI) selected 11 AOP and 15 SABIP startup ideas from across the country for the Incubation programme.

The inaugural ceremony of incubation programme for Cohort was held on 19th June, 2024 on virtual platform.

During the 1 month incubation program, the prominent sessions of the incubation program include Launchpad Strategies for Startup Success, Effective Pitch Deck Preparation, Business Idea Validation, Vision Alignment for Entrepreneurship, **Ensuring Sustainability of Startups, Startup** to Scale-up: Accelerate Your Growth, Investment Readiness of Startups, Startup Valuation, How to mitigate risks faced by Startups & Company Law for Startups, Go-To-Market Strategies for Startups, Customer Segment & Market Analysis, Lean Startup & Business Model Canvas, Funding Schemes for Startups, Digital Marketing Strategies for Agri-Startups, Market Research Techniques, Product Market Fit, Export Opportunities and Challenges for Agri-Startups, Role of APEDA in promoting Agri startups, Significance of Intellectual Property Rights, Reverse Pitching and others.
